Entry Conditions

- Open to members and non members
- All exhibitors must complete a Record of Attendance at Horse Event form before competing. To be collected by CCHS NSW Branch Secretary.
- All horses competing in led classes must be registered with the Commonwealth Clydesdale Horse Society.
- All horses competing in Harness classes must be registered with either the Commonwealth Clydesdale Horse Society or registered with other recognized heavy horse society
- Horses competing in all working classes must be in Winker set, Collar & Hames, Back band & Chains and suitable harness in other events.
- Harness Classes open to mares and geldings only
- Horses must be presented in good clean condition
- Harness and tack must be in a safe working condition
- Exhibitors must be suitably attired whilst in the ring
- Non CCHS members must pay for Day Membership for the show event to participate. (an Insurance levy of \$11.00 per day)
- Junior Exhibitors must be a Junior Member prior to the event to enter classes. Forms are available from the Federal Secretary or branch with membership of \$11.00 payable if not a member
- Insurance waivers must be signed on the day by all persons entering the ring.
- All entrants to pay horse fees \$2.20 each horse and camping fees if camping (All are charges by Camden Equestrian Park)
- Colts and Stallions 1 year and over must be shown in suitable headgear and a bit
- Competent Adult 18 years and over must be charge of colt/stallion in show ring
- Insurance waivers must be signed on the day

- Previous winners of the Land Cup not eligible
- Horse must be owned by not necessarily bred by the exhibitor

- 3) Junior Driver in Long Rein Mare/Gelding (17 yrs and under) – Must be accompanied by an Adult
- 4) Driven Single Horse in Long Rein by a Novice – To be judged on Workout
